Principal's Report

Welcome BBQ/ Parent Information sessions

It was wonderful to see lots of our families at last Tuesday's Welcome BBQ and Information evening! My thanks to our P&C for organising and running our tasty BBQ. I trust all of our families enjoyed a lovely social and informative evening.

Reward Day

Thursday 27 March is the first of our twice-per-term reward days. These days are to reward students for their respectful, responsible and safe behaviour, both in the classroom and the playground. Students who have not been in Time-Out over the past five weeks are eligible to attend. Our first reward day is a very exciting activities afternoon.

School Attendance

It has come to my attention that the level of school attendance of some of our students is not meeting the NSW Department of Education standards. We are experiencing a pattern of some students regularly arriving late to school, leaving early or wanting to go home sick. It might not seem much but if it is occurring on a regular basis, it can add up to a lot of schooling/learning being missed. If your child's attendance drops below a certain percentage, we as a school need to notify the Department of Education. Appointments need to be made out of school hours when possible and routines need to be established at home in order to have your child to school on time. Not being able to get a car park at 3:20 is not an acceptable reason for taking your child out of school early! When students arrive late or leave early it is recorded as a partial absence on the class roll, which is a legal document. Full day absences must be justified

on the student's return to school. I am in the process of meeting with and sending letters home to families, regarding any attendance concerns that the school may have.

Headlice

The departmental procedure when head lice have been sighted/ reported, is to notify via a letter to all students in the class and recommend that parents do a thorough check of their child's hair. We understand the frustration for parents if their child has had several cases, after they have been diligent in treating their child. It is vitally important that ALL parents check their child's hair once a notification is sent home, and to treat appropriately in order to ensure no further outbreaks. I have requested that teachers inform me if they identify head lice in a child's hair, and will be contacting those parents individually to advise of this. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.

As part of our positive behaviour initiatives, last Thursday saw the announcement of our fortnightly House Champs – well done to Latham students who managed to achieve a total of 273 points for respectful, responsible and safe behaviour and positive classroom effort.
